Aim of the contest

The Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office (Tokyo), which represents the HKSAR government in Japan, is organizing an English Speech competition among students in Japan. The purpose is to deepen understanding of Hong Kong among the youth community, and to strengthen friendship and goodwill between Hong Kong and Japan.

- 2) Students from a country or territory where English is the first or second language are not eligible to enter.

 - * Please do not staple or clip the typed speech
 - (4) CD/R, cassette tape or mp3, wma data with recording of the speech delivered within the prescribed time (bearing the name and university of the applicant)
 - * The tapes or CD/R will not be returned.
 - * The copyright of the speeches submitted will belong to the organizer.

Speech:

Seven minutes for the prepared speech, three minutes for questions and answers on the speech.

- 1) Time limit of the speech
 - A. The length of the speech is seven minutes or less. Any speech exceeding seven minutes will be deducted from the total score.
 - B. After giving an introduction, the contestants must immediately proceed to the podium. The duration of the speech starts to be measured when the speaker starts to speak.
- 2) Method of assessing speeches
Adjudicators will assess the speeches in terms of four criteria: English, content, delivery, and questions and answers.
